2. Imagination is essential to living by faith.

What is faith? It is the confident assurance that what we hope for is going to happen. It is the evidence of things we cannot yet see. **Hebrews 11:1 (NLT)**

We set our eyes not on what we see but on what we cannot see. What we see will last only a short time, but what we cannot see will last forever. **2 Corinthians 4:18 (ICB)**

3. Great lives are built around great dreams



May God enlighten the eyes of your mind so that you can see the hope that his calling holds for you. **Ephesians 1:18 (NIV)**
